What is this program?

- Interactive broadcasts with leaders of the executive, judicial and legislative branches talking about their role in government and their reflections on public service. **The purpose of this program is to give students an opportunity to appreciate the role of public servants in our government and to move past election year rhetoric.** The final broadcast will be a discussion of various service-learning projects, including Project Citizen examples, with teachers, community partners and students as well as information about applying for Service-Learning grants.
- A pre-recorded program on linking service learning with civic education featuring inspiring dialogue with two students who take being a good citizen very seriously.
- Each broadcast will have an in-house audience of one of the participating schools. All expense will be paid, including overnight lodging if necessary. What is the cost?

FREE – absolutely no cost to you or your school. Study guides and enrichment activities will be posted on www.mobar.org.

Who is the program for?

All high school, junior high and middle school history, civics and government teachers.

When are the broadcasts?

The pre-recorded program will be available through ESGN beginning in December. The first broadcast will be the week of January 19th. The other programs will be the weeks of February 2, February 16 and March 3. The programs will begin at 9:00 a.m. and run for forty-five minutes. Tentatively, the programs will air on a Wednesday or Thursday.

Must we participate in every broadcast for it to be meaningful?

No. Every participating class should preview the pre-recorded program and all other programs are available either as an interactive broadcast or in the ESGN archives.

How do I access the program both as an interactive program and on archives?
