

ENROLLMENT FEE DISTRIBUTION

Enrollment fees paid by the approximately 29,000 members of The Missouri Bar finance the operations of two separate organizations serving the needs of those attorneys. These organizations are The Missouri Bar and the Office of Chief Disciplinary Counsel located in Jefferson City.

By rule of the Supreme Court of Missouri, all lawyers admitted to practice in this state are required to pay an annual enrollment fee.

The fee categories are as follows:

Category 1

Lawyers admitted more than 3 years
\$305 total fee (see fee distribution below)

Category 2

Lawyers admitted less than 3 years
\$250 total fee (see fee distribution below)

Category 3

Non-resident (licensed but neither residing, practicing, nor employed in Missouri)
\$220 total fee (see fee distribution below)

Inactive Status

Any lawyer who is currently not stricken from the roll of attorneys and who ceases to practice law in this state \$50 total fee (see fee distribution below)

The fees are distributed as follows:

Category 1

- \$184 to support Missouri Bar programs and activities
- \$101 to support the disciplinary system
- \$20 to support Legal Aid

Category 2

- \$129 to support Missouri Bar programs and activities
- \$101 to support the disciplinary system
- \$20 to support Legal Aid

Category 3

- \$119 to support Missouri Bar programs and activities
- \$101 to support the disciplinary system

Inactive Status

- \$25 to support Missouri Bar programs and activities
- \$25 to support the disciplinary system

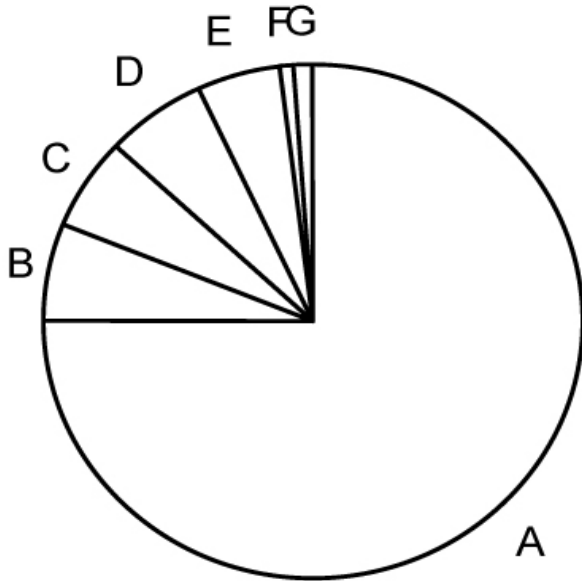

2008 Receipts and Disbursements



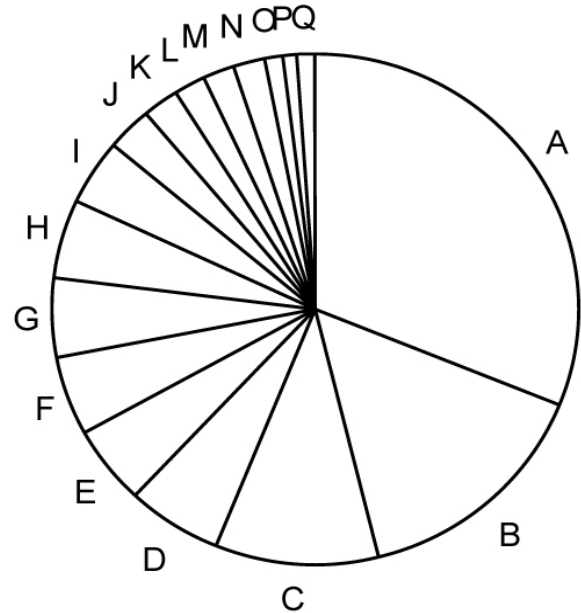

Missouri Bar Enrollment Fees

The Missouri Bar's portion of the enrollment fees, plus penalties for late payment of those fees, was \$4,546,000 for 2008.

In addition, approximately \$560,000 was allocated to support Legal Aid in Missouri.
